



Now we add II Compound Vowels to finish all the 21 vowels of Hangeul





게장 "Gejang" is made by marinating fresh raw (preferably live) crab in soy sauce.

There is a spicy version marinated in a chilli powder based sauce.

Korean Beginners Level 1

- When we refer to person instead using their name, Koreans tend to use these pronouns
 - 개(그 아이) the person who we are talking about
 - 쟤(저 아이) that person
 - **0**#(0| 0|0|) this person
- Korean makes extensive use of speech levels and honorifics in its grammar. Pronouns change depending on the social distinction of the speaker and the person being spoken to
- Typically, these short forms (개, 재, 애) are used only to the those younger than the speaker or in a private conversation referring to a 3rd person (who won't hear!) 개, 재, 애


- Morning prayers at 4 or 5 am then services throughout the day



PRONOUNCING DOUBLE CONSONANTS

Korean Beginners Level 1

- Double consonants are pronounced harder than their basic consonants
 - However, it is important to pronounce in the context of words

- You don't need to memorise the names of all the consonants/double consonants
 - e.g. 기역 "giyeok"



떡 (TTEOK) KOREAN RICE CAKE

Korean Beginners Level 1

- Over 200 different kinds of 떡 are made in Korea
 - For breakfast, everyday snacks and for special occasions
- Base is steamed flour from various grains including glutinous or non-glutinous rice. Steamed flour can be pounded, shaped or pan-fried to make tteok.
- Common additional ingredients
 - Red bean, soybean, mung bean, mug wort, pumpkin, chestnut
 - Pine nut and jujube, dried fruits, sesame seeds, sesame oil and honey.




















Under Buddhist influence, especially during the Kingdom of Goryeo, killing and eating animals was forbidden. This led to various Korean vegetable dishes including Ssam.
